

HISTORICAL NOTES

The New York Seniors Golf Association was organized in 1952.

For 17 years the New York State Golf Association sponsored a Senior Championship. This was always a match play event in conjunction with the regular State Amateur Championship.

In 1952 a group of Seniors met with officials of the New York State Golf Association and secured the approval of the State Association for the formation of the New York Seniors Golf Association.

Harry R. Harman, Oscar D. Guilfoil, Jr., Romeyn Scribner, Sherrill Sherman, and Jack Ahern were the men who accomplished this separation.

This group wrote the By-Laws, incorporated, and generally organized our present association.

The objective of our organization is to promote friendly competition and good fellowship among senior golfers.
